
# Report of analysis feedback on curriculum collected from various stakeholders for the Academic year 2018-19


The data was collected and analyzed by IQAC. In general positive feedback was received as all the stakeholders expressed satisfaction with respect to content and design of the curriculum.


## **Students Feedback:**



















#### Conclusion


Most of the students are satisfied with course content and curriculum, helpful for both Placements and Higher Education. Timely updating of Curriculum is recommended.


## Faculty Feedback
