
Report of analysis feedback on curriculum collected from various stakeholders for the Academic year 2029-21

Students Feedback:




Faculty Feedback


Employer Feedback:

Employer feedback is collected and analysed taken on the syllabus designed by Bengaluru City University. We have received total 4 employer's feedback for the current academic year.


