Program No 1: "YOUTH 2 CHILDREN"

The objective of this initiative is to ensure the educated youth volunteers take initiatives to spend their efforts and time on making the underprivileged students of government schools and orphanage children (in country like India, where a lot of government schools need better education) Educated

A lot of third world countries have student population who don't go for higher studies and they are deprived of quality education. Execution

This project has done under the Institutional Social Responsibility committee (Seva Spandana). This project done by 04 Students of B.Com in government schools surrounding of the college by taking few sessions in governments schools in the month of October from 09.10.2017 to 14.10.2017.

Under this project, our students taught basics of English, Maths, Science, Health and Hygiene and importance of cleanliness and time management to government school kids.



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Outcome

Our students learnt to come out from comfort zone and start investing their time towards constructive work for their development and as well as societal development. They improved their communication and cracking permission with different authority to execute this project.

Government school kids learnt about the above-mentioned points in execution and it impacted them on different perspective.

Program No 2: "36 MEALS"

36 Meals is the project which will give highest satisfaction after the execution according to the feedback received from the students which we had received after the first execution of the pioneer batch. With a very good feedback and inputs from the IQAC, Seva Spandana had decided to take this project to the next level.

Objectives of this project is mainly to bring awareness about the wastages of food, how wastages of food affect the society and what will be the best impact if we stop wasting food.

Execution

36 Meals project had been executed under the Institutional Social Responsibility committee (Seva Spandana). Before executing this project students raised the fund from public and utilized the same to execute the project. This project had been executed by 15 students of B.com. Students went to the prime areas of Bangalore like Majestic and K R Market and distributed the food which was collected by all the students and donated it to the needy people to bring awareness about the food wastage by donating food the programme was held on 16.09.2017.

Outcome

Executors of this project have learnt to make plans for raising fund from public, how to face rejection, etc. They also have learnt how to utilize the fund effectively in social projects. They have learnt the coordination and the team building. This project made them to understand the importance of food.



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Public were asked not to waste food and bring awareness about importance of food and also to donate food for needy people in their own capacity.

Program No 3: "NEWS PAPER BAG"

SSNPB is an initiative under the objective of ISR body of the college to re-use the resources. This is to reduce plastic campaign. An initiative to convert the Newspaper into bags of different sizes and provide it to different shopping outlets in the vicinity to encourage them to reduce the use of plastic bags.

Objective:

Saving Trees: As it makes use of already printed Newspaper, it avoids manufacturing of fresh paper, and avoids cutting of trees. "A tree not cut, is a tree planted". In a world like today, where usage of all resources is so high, avoiding wastage is in itself creating resource.

Execution:

This project has done under the Institutional Social Responsibility committee (Seva Spandana) as pioneer batch to see the outcome of the project. 18 Students visited different schools nearby Seshadripuram and thought how to make news paper bag and the bag what we got out of it. We donated them to stores to bring awareness to avoid the using of plastic. The program was held on 22.02.2018.

Outcome:

Outcome of the project is really good in its pioneer batch. Before implementing the project, our students learnt how to prepare news paper bag, they also learnt to convince the school to participate in this social project. They also learnt to teach school kids and they successfully executed the project by making school kids involve in this. This is the best outcome of this project.

Program No 4: "LET'S WRITE TOGETHER"

This is also one of the initiatives under the objectives of re-use the resources "A PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN SWORD" but how well do you use! To make better use of used pens we source them, make it better and gift it to the needy.



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Execution:

This project had different kind of resource collection and similar type of execution. Execution team collected empty pens from the students and filled that pen with new refills and distributed them to the school children. 18 members have joined for this program. The program was held on 02.11.2017.

This project is totally wealth from waste kind of project, from this project our students learnt how to re-use the disposable product. Patience was one of the very big learning for the students from this project where they spent hours together time to add new refills to old pens according to the requirements.
