I Semester:

- Students are made more aware of socially relevant themes such as women's property rights, the needs of the disabled, the value of hard labour, and the importance of reforestation through the writings of literary giants like Orwell, O. Henry, Gibran, and Ruskin Bond, among others.

II Semester:

- Through the literary section, which includes texts by renowned international and Indian writers like Maya Angelou, Saki, and Kamala Das, Talces takes readers on a journey through socially relevant issues like dowry and problems facing women, the vulnerabilities of the elderly, racial discrimination, the need for equality, the effects of war, environmental degradation, and the power of creativity.
- Through the workbook component, students are prepared with practical writing and speaking abilities like writing letters of inquiry, précis writing, and dialogue in diverse situations.
